

INTRODUCTION

Hook Sentence—Begin with the “hook” which can be a brief story or something else that catches the reader’s attention.

General Statement about your topic—this should explain how your “hook” connects with your paper topic, in a generalized way. Save specifics for the thesis sentence.

More focused statement about your topic—This is where you start to really focus in. This sentence connects the general statement to your thesis statement.

Thesis sentence—this should be a very inclusive, compound sentence that lets the reader know what to expect in the paper ahead. You should have revised this many times since day one.

CONCLUSION



Reinforce the thesis sentence—this should be a very inclusive, compound sentence that sums up the gist of the paper. It gives the reader a feeling of satisfaction.



Highlight the main points from your paper.



Close with a nice, dramatic, memorable end.
